<sup>3</sup>Students intending to pursue a bachelor's degree may opt to complete HLT 230 instead of HLT 138.

<sup>4</sup>Students will be required to submit a course substitution form to the Dean of Health Professions upon completion of alternate courses.

\*NUR 226 is a recommended course, offered during summer term.

The grade point average is determined by dividing the total number of grade points earned by the total number of credits attempted. (Developmental credits are not included in this computation.) Grade points are computed by multiplying the number of credits completed by the points for the grades earned. For example, BIO 102 (4 credits), the student earned a B (3 points) = 12 grade points.

A = 4 grade points per credit

B = 3 grade points per credit

C = 2 grade points per credit

D = 1 grade point per credit

F = 0 grade points
