CAVEATS & INSTRUCTIONS

The information you have given us will be used to compute an Expected Family Contribution (EFC). With that information, we will send you an **estimate** of how much aid you may be eligible for at Bethel College. This is **NOT** an offer of aid. We hope this is helpful as you consider Bethel as an option for your future.

- 1. We must have the student's social security number to compute the estimate.
- 2. Student's birthday
- 3. Single, married, separated, divorced, widowed
- 4. If your parents are separated or divorced, use the state of legal residence for the parent whose information is reported on this form
- 5. Enter the age of the older parent for whom you are giving information on this form
- 6. Enter the number of people in your household your parents will support. Include your parents and yourself. Include your parent's other children if they get more than half their support from your parents. Include other people only if they now live with you and will get more than half of their support from your parents.
- 7. Include yourself and any other family members who will be enrolled at least halftime and working towards a degree.
- 8. Enter an estimate if you have not completed your 2014 tax forms.
- 9. Include the current balance of checking or savings accounts. Do not include IRA's.
- 10. Do not include a family farm if your parents live on and operate. **Do not include home equity**.
- 11. Enter the amount of equity (value minus debt) if you own a business with more than 100 empl.
- 12. This should be your cumulative high school <u>G</u>rade <u>Point Average</u>, based on a 4.0 scale after at least 6 semesters, or your accumulative college GPA after 24 college hours.

- 15. Mark yes if at least one **grandparent**, **parent**, **spouse**, **or sibling** attended Bethel College.
