feedback! This means that each buyer has been pleased with the transaction.

So how does it work? Well, sellable items are donated to Roxie's Fund, and Kris completes the listing process on eBay to sell the item, including taking pictures and writing a description. She monitors the auction, answering any questions that buyers might have. Then she completes the transaction by sending an invoice, waiting for payment (usually with PayPal) and mailing the package!

What items can be donated? Almost anything can find a buyer on eBay! But the best-selling items are name-brand items in good condition and that aren't too big to mail easily (think about gifts you'd like to regift!). Kris has recently auctioned off over 30 listings of craft items including popular rubber stamps. The net proceeds totaled over \$700!
