BUSINESS WOMENS ASSOCIATION CALL FOR TOP NOMINEES FOR 2015 REGIONAL BUSINESS ACHIEVERS AWARDS

The qualifying criteria for each of the categories in which awards are presented are set out below.

EMERGING ENTREPRENEUR

In order to be nominated in this category:

- Nominees are required to operate an entrepreneurial enterprise as a sole proprietorship, a partnership (where at least 50% of the partnership interest is held by the nominee), a member of a close corporation or as a shareholder of a company (where at least 26% of the share capital or members' interest is held by the nominee);
- Nominees are required to have held a directorship or senior management position within the entrepreneurial enterprise for at least one year.
- The entrepreneurial enterprise must have been trading for less than five years.
- Only one shareholder, member or partner from the entrepreneurial enterprise may be nominated in same fiscal year.
- The entrepreneurial enterprise must not be operating at a loss.
- The entrepreneurial enterprise may be a franchises, micro or small business.

ENTREPRENEUR

In order to be nominated in this category:

- Nominees are required to operate an entrepreneurial enterprise as a sole proprietorship, a partnership (where at least 50% of the partnership interest is held by the nominee), a member of a close corporation or as a shareholder of a company (where at least 26% of the share capital or members' interest is held by the nominee);
- Nominees are required to have held a directorship or senior management position within the entrepreneurial enterprise for at least three years.
- Only one shareholder, member or partner from the entrepreneurial enterprise may be nominated in same fiscal year.
- The entrepreneurial enterprise must not be operating at a loss.
- The entrepreneurial enterprise may be a franchise, micro or small business.

PROFESSIONAL

In order to be nominated in this category:

- Nominees must be practicing professional persons holding formal qualifications in their profession and a professional body accreditation, i.e. a doctor, attorney, architect, pharmacist, professional nurse, etc.
- Nominees must be engaged in their profession as a means of livelihood.
- Nominees must have been in practice, or employed in a professional capacity for more than one year and must hold a position as a director, senior manager or partner.
- Nominees must have a direct involvement in the finances of the practice, partnership, corporate division, government division or NGO in which they hold their position.
- The practice or division run or managed by the nominees must be profitable and / or governed by sound financial practices.
- Nominees must be endorsed by the managing partner / director / CEO or relevant professional body and such endorsement must accompany the submissions made by nominees upon accepting their nomination.

CORPORATE

In order to be nominated in this category:

- Nominees must be employed by private or public companies, educational institutions, parastatal or state owned companies.
- Nominees must have been employed in their current position for at least one financial year.
- Nominees must hold a senior management or leadership position.
- Nominees must control a budget of less than R 75 million.
- Nominees must be endorsed by the managing partner, director or CEO of their employer and such endorsement must accompany the submissions made by nominees upon accepting their nomination.
- Nominees must be role models within their employers' business or their community and in this regard, special focus is had on transformation and mentorship within such a business or community.

SOCIAL ENTREPRENEUR

In order to be nominated in this category:

- Nominees must have held a position within a company, foundation, NGO or non-profit company NPO for or with whom they work for at least one year.
- Nominees must control or be fully involved in the budgeting and financial affairs of the organisation, and must be able to show a track record of income received and expenditure made on projects.
- The organisation by whom nominees are employed or with whom they work must financially sustainable.
- Nominees must be able to provide evidence of how they have applied practical, innovative and sustainable approaches to benefit their community. In this regard, the following criteria will be applied:-
 - Direct social impact of their social entrepreneurial undertakings
 - Innovation shown by nominees in tackling social issues
 - Scale of projects and initiatives undertaken by nominees
 - Sustainability of organisations and initiatives linked to nominees
 - Nature of the values developed and implemented by nominees.

GOVERNMENT

In order to be nominated in this category:

- Nominees must be employed by parastatals, local or provincial government or educational institutions (primary, secondary or tertiary institutions).
- Nominees must have held their current position for at least one financial year.
- Nominees must hold a senior management or leadership position.
- Nominees must control a budget of less than R 75 million.
- Nominees must be endorsed by the director of their employer or their immediate manager and such endorsement must accompany the submissions made by nominees upon accepting their nomination.
- Nominees must be role models within their employers' business or their community and, in this regard, special focus is had on transformation and mentorship within such a business or community.

HOW TO ENTER A NOMINEE
