



Annual Convention Poll Results

Responses to the SEAOH questionnaire regarding the recent low participation rate of structural engineers were received and tallied. 39 polls (32 engineers, 2 product suppliers, 1 contractor) were returned with good comments. The primary reasons for not attending the convention, in order of importance, were "Travel and hotel cost too high" followed up by "No time, too busy" and "Technical seminars not interesting".

The suggested methods to increase participation, in order of priority, were "Have majority of conventions on Oahu", followed up by a tie between "Reduce registration cost by selecting lower cost venues" and "Reduce registration cost by reinstating technical session registration fee only". There was also a substantial vote for "Change frequency of convention to biannual basis". Other common suggested methods to increase participation include scheduling the convention during summer months and improving quality of the technical

sessions

The Board would like to thank those who participated in the questionnaire and the Convention Committee will take these comments into consideration when planning future conventions to better serve the needs of our members. National Council of Structural Engineer Association (NCSEA):

The NCSEA requested SEAOH to vote to support or not support NCSEA's position statement for Continuing Professional Development. The SEAOH officers and directors voted to support the NCSEA position statement for Continuing Professional Development of all licensed structural engineers. 
