Legacy Scholarship ******* (Amount determined after Pell Grant is applied)

For new, full-time** on campus students who have been accepted to the Bachelor of Arts program. Legacy Scholarship covers only the remaining cost of tuition, after the student's Pell Grant is applied. Scholarship recipients must file the FAFSA. Students eligible for the Federal Pell Grant must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress. Additional requirements include maintaining a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00, participate in all HCU required campaigns, and complete at least 15 hours per semester of HCU service components. (Excludes the HCU Campaign Scholarship).

HCU Campaign Scholarship (\$1000.00) ***

For new students taking 12 or more semester credit hours on campus^{**} who did not receive the Legacy scholarship. Student is awarded the scholarship upon fulfillment of the required campaign criteria. Scholarship will be applied to the student's account. In each subsequent semester, the scholarship will be awarded provided the student maintains a semester GPA of at least 3.00, enrolls for at least 12 credit hours, ** and fulfills all campaign requirements for the current semester.

Distance Learning Scholarship (\$500.00) ***

For new online students who are true distance learners (live at least 150 miles from the HCU campus). Student must enroll for at least 6 credit hours** each semester. Students are awarded a scholarship of \$500.00. In each subsequent semester, the scholarship will be awarded provided the student maintains a term GPA of at least 3.00, enrolls for at least 6 credit hours,** and maintains distance learning status as indicated above.

Spouse of Full-time Degree Seeking HCU Student or the Spouse of a Full-time Preacher* Scholarship

For the spouse of a full-time degree seeking HCU student <u>or</u> the spouse of a full-time preacher. Student is awarded a onehalf off tuition scholarship. The scholarship may continue for one year after his or her spouse graduates. (Excludes all other scholarships on this form).

Dependent children of full-time preacher*, Christian School Administrator*or Faculty member* Scholarship

For dependent children of a full-time preacher, Christian school administrator or faculty member. Student is awarded a onehalf off tuition scholarship for four consecutive years of enrollment. (Excludes all other scholarships on this form).

Full-Time Youth Minister* Scholarship *** (Must provide letter from congregational leaders)

For a full-time Youth Minister (compensated, staff member position). Student is awarded a one-half off tuition scholarship. Student must maintain a term GPA of at least 2.75 to maintain eligibility each semester. Student may receive this award for up to four consecutive years of enrollment. (Excludes all other scholarships on this form).

Lads to Leaders Scholarship ******* (No more than two years from high school graduation)

For participants in the Lads to Leaders program. Student is awarded scholarship based on a résumé of participation and accomplishments submitted to the HCU Scholarship Committee. Student must maintain a term GPA of at least 3.00 to maintain eligibility each semester. Student may receive this award for up to four consecutive years of enrollment. L2L Scholarships are subject to university policies and guidelines. An award of a one-half off tuition will exclude all other scholarships on this form.

High School Honors Scholarship *** (No more than two years from high school graduation)

For high school Valedictorian or Salutatorian who enroll for at least 12 credit hours.** Student is awarded a one-half off tuition scholarship. Student must maintain a term GPA of at least 3.00 to maintain eligibility each semester. Student may receive this award for up to four consecutive years of enrollment. An official high school transcript or an official honors award certificate must be submitted for verification. (Excludes all other scholarships on this form).

SGA Officers Scholarship (\$200.00) ***

For HCU SGA elected Officers (President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasure). Eligibility requires Officer to maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.50. <u>Officers are not eligible for scholarship if placed on academic probation</u>.

□ Graduate Student On-Campus Scholarship

For all graduate classes (MA, MMin, and M.Div.) taken on-campus. Student will receive a scholarship of 25% off tuition only. This scholarship applies to full-time, half-time, and less than half-time on-campus enrollment only.

*As determined by Heritage Christian University, ** At least 12 credit hours undergrad, at least 9 credit hours graduate = full-time, all credit hours must be taken at HCU, *** HCU regulations allow for student appeal in the loss of Academic Scholarships if extenuating circumstances exist.
