International Education Subcommittee eContouring Ambassador Initiative

The purpose of the International Education Subcommittee eContouring Ambassador Initiative is to expand the reach of contouring training to countries outside of the United States and Canada who can demonstrate a training gap and/or need. The eContouring Ambassador Initiative provides opportunities for both domestic ambassadors traveling abroad and international ambassadors wishing to bring contouring training to their facility, region, or country.

Features include:

- Expert speakers from the US and Canada
- Web-based eContouring software (shown at right)
- Opportunity to anonymously compare contours between all attendees and the speaker's expert contours
- Options for both domestic and international ambassadors

Domestic Ambassador Option

Domestic ambassadors seeking access to ASTRO eContouring resources to teach a contouring session on an upcoming radiation oncology-related international trip. The design of this training will be left up to the domestic ambassador and host facility. However, the domestic ambassador will have access to and can share with the host facility on-demand recordings of previous eContouring sessions (known as Package 3).

Process Overview:

- 1) A domestic ambassador is identified (they must be an ASTRO member).
- 2) The domestic ambassador completes the application form.
- 3) The application is submitted to ASTRO staff who will review it for completeness.
- 4) Completed evaluations are sent to IES who will review the application.
- 5) If an application is approved, a call will be setup between ASTRO staff and the international ambassador to outline next steps and answer any questions the ambassador may have about the process.
- 6) The domestic ambassador conducts a didactic training for the host facility. If desired, the ambassador can use the ondemand recordings during their training and/or can share them with the host facility afterwards.
- 7) After the training, the domestic ambassador will complete a short online evaluation.

Optional International Ambassador Training

- Opportunity to observe (no access to cases) up to 2 ASTRO Annual Meeting eContouring sessions based on the education need of the facility the ambassador will be visiting. Observation or participation (access to cases) in additional sessions will be at the cost of the ambassador. The ambassador is also responsible for all meeting-related expenses.
- View up to 4 topic-relevant on-demand virtual meeting sessions from previous Annual Meetings.

^{*} Host facilities are responsible for any costs associated with the registering attendees on the vendor website and teleconference fees if using ASTRO's webinar software.

International Ambassador Option

This option is available to international ambassadors seeking ASTRO assistance to train radiation oncologists in contouring in their local facility, region or country. This training will consist of two components. The first is that a speaker who will deliver a lecture and review contours via a live webinar (host facilities are required to pay webinar fees). The second is that attendees will practice their contouring skills before and after the live webinar (host facilities are required to pay software vendor fees).

Process Overview:

- 1) An international ambassador from the host facility, region, or country is identified (they must be an ASTRO member).
- 2) The international ambassador completes the application form (package options are shown in the table below).
- 3) The application is submitted to ASTRO staff who will review it for completeness.
- 4) Completed evaluations are sent to IES who will review the application.
- 5) If an application is approved, a call will be setup between ASTRO staff and the international ambassador to outline next steps, answer any questions the ambassador may have about the process, determine if ASTRO's webinar software will be used, and determine if a speaker will be needed.
- 6) ASTRO staff will work with the international ambassador, speaker, and software vendor to set a date and time for the training.
- 7) The international ambassador will be put in touch with the contouring software vendor will work with them to register attendees (pre-payment is required at least 30 days before the live training).
- 8) ASTRO staff and the speaker will conduct a rehearsal 1-2 weeks before the live training if ASTRO's webinar software is being used for the training.
- 9) The live training is held.
- 10) After the training, the international ambassador will complete a short online evaluation of this process.

Optional International Ambassador Training:

- Participate in (with case access) up to 2 eContouring sessions at the ASTRO Annual Meeting based on the educational need of the home country at a discounted fee of \$55 per session. Opportunity to observe (no access to cases) up to 2 additional ASTRO Annual Meeting eContouring sessions based on the education need of the host facility. Participation in additional sessions, as well as meeting-related expenses, will be at the cost of the ambassador.
- View up to 4 topic-relevant on-demand virtual meeting sessions from previous Annual Meetings.
