The cost for camp is \$_____, \$_____ for out of council and provisional troop Scouts. You will want to have some extra money for trading-post items, souvenirs and to pay for some merit badge costs like handicrafts, basketry and shotgun shooting. (About \$40 should do.)

Mail is delivered into camp once a day and a letter or postcard can take anywhere from one to three days to get to camp. The letter from home can be one of the greatest cures for both homesickness and getting down to work. Because of the extra time and handling involved, please do not send mail or packages that have to be signed for. Our experience shows that many of these items are returned to sender instead of reaching your Scout. (It is recommended that your mail be sent no later than Tuesday for receipt before he leaves camp.)
