NAN Middle School Intensive is designed for the young artist interested in an in-depth exploration of contemporary art practices and mediums.

This eight week long after school program gives students the opportunity to work closely with professional St. Louis based artists and educators in an atmosphere of focused attention and mentorship.

Twelve students from the greater St. Louis area are selected to focus on one particular practice or medium each semester.

The program occurs every Thursday afternoon for 8 weeks from 4:30-6:00pm. It is tuition-free for accepted students. Refreshments and supplies are provided.
