Only DMM members who attended the September 2013 meeting (or who were formally excused) may enter students into this Scholarship Auditions.

Fall Convention • Saturday, November 16, 2013

Dancer – Print this “Signature Sheet” and turn it in with your Form.

Teacher – Obtain all required signatures on this sheet (and additional sheets if necessary). Include these signatures with Scholarship Audition forms in your Convention Registration packet.

Awards for Senior and Junior Auditions

Only students of DMM members in good standing are eligible to audition for the following DMM scholarships. Monetary awards are paid to the teacher(s) of record:

- Each Overall place winner and each Subject First place winner receives a tuition-only scholarship to attend the 2014 DMM Spring (Performing Arts) Workshop and Fall Convention.
- Overall First place winners receive a \$250 scholarship for lessons.
- Overall Second place winners receive a \$150 scholarship for lessons.
- Additional scholarships for lessons will be awarded to: Overall Third place, \$125; Overall Fourth place, \$100; Overall Fifth place, \$75.
- Also, First place winners by subject receive \$50 scholarships for lessons, and Second place winners by subject receive \$25 scholarships for lessons.

- And up to 20 tuition-only scholarships to attend 2014 DMM Spring and/or Fall Conventions will be awarded.

Determination of awards is subject to change by the DMM Board of Directors

Rules for Entrants

All teachers must be DMM members and registered for the Fall Convention.

- **Junior Entrants** must be between 7 and 12 years of age as of June 1, 2014.
- **Senior Entrants** must be between 13 and 23 years of age as of June 1, 2014.
- **Entrant must be enrolled as a student with the teacher of record and**
 1. for a period of at least ten (10) months prior to the Scholarship Audition;
 2. with written permission from the former teacher, if the student has studied with the teacher of record for a period of less than ten (10) months prior to the Competition; or

3. has studied with the teacher of record for at least three (3) years, has less than one (1) year lapse in training with the teacher of record, and is now in a position that does not permit the entrant to study with the teacher of record on a regular basis.

Dress Code for Scholarship Auditions

- Women:** Black leotard (any style), pink tights for ballet, pink or suntan for other subjects.
- Males:** White top, black tights or jazz pants (as appropriate).
- Shoes:** Appropriate for each subject.
- Hair:** Secured neatly and off the neck. No jewelry, shorts, shirts, pants etc. are permitted.
- Anyone not in proper attire **will be disqualified** from the audition.
