1. BACKGROUND

The Sedibeng Tourism Awards programme represents the highest possible accolade to the tourism industry players in the Sedibeng region. It is an annual, prestigious event that acknowledges rewards and promotes service excellence in the local tourism industry and aims to promote Sedibeng as a region of excellence and preferred tourist destination.

The Sedibeng District Municipality will be hosting the 3rd Annual Sedibeng Tourism Awards on Thursday, 10 April 2014.

As the organisation of this event requires particular skills relevant to an event of this nature, the Sedibeng District Municipality wishes to appoint a service provider to provide a venue and to arrange, manage and deliver on behalf of the Council, as specified in the requirements below:
