ELIGIBILITY

Members of all Divisions of Biathlon Canada and the United States Biathlon Association, in good standing may participate in this event if they have a valid USBA or Biathlon Canada Competitor membership. Non-members must purchase day permits for each of the competition days in order to participate in the events.

CADET PARTICIPATION

Cadet Corps wishing to compete with Corps air rifles or .22 rifles must ensure to fill out their appropriate RSS within their own region prior to registration, and are exempt from purchasing a day membership as long as their participation has been approved and sanctioned by their respective Cadet region.

MEDALS & POINTS CUP

Ontario Cup medals will be awarded to the top three athletes of each category opened. Medals will follow the competition final results. Presentation of the Hurley Cup will be presented after the results of Saturday's race.

PROTESTS

All protests must be submitted in writing to the Competition Secretary, in accordance with IBU event and competition rules along with a deposit \$25.00 (CAN). Deposits will be returned only if the protest is upheld by the competition jury. If a protest is rejected, the protest fee will be kept by the Organizing Committee. REMARKS

The event will be run in accordance with the IBU rules. Biathlon Canada rules and procedures will be used for competitors not carrying rifles. Cadets Canada rules will apply for those who are racing as Cadets.

Senior Boy & Senior Girl .22 cal rifle categories: Athletes will take possession of their rifle from rifle rack upon entering the range and will leave the rifle on the rifle rack upon exiting the range.

Junior Boy, Junior Girl, and Cadet .22 cal rifle categories: The coach will place the rifle on the mat upon the arrival of the athlete who will shoot in prone position only.

All .22 cal rifle athletes (excluding Junior Boy, Junior Girl, & Cadet categories): Current law and legislation regarding the possession and use of firearms must be followed and a <u>firearms licence must be</u> presented upon arrival for participation in this event.

Air rifle categories: The coach will place the rifle on the mat upon the arrival of the athlete.

NOTE: The Organizing Committee is not responsible to provide .22 caliber rifles, air rifles, or ammunition.




Driving directions from Algoma's Water Tower Inn and Suites (A) to Algoma Rod & Gun Club (B).
