Kehila Chadasha welcomes your participation in services for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Rabbi David Shneyer will again lead services this year. **Services will be held at Walter Johnson High School at 6400 Rock Spring Drive in Bethesda.** On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Rosh Hashanah (September 15<sup>th</sup>), services will be held outdoors at the Viers Mill Park Activity Building at 4425 Garrett Park Road, Wheaton, MD.

Tickets for the services are limited, so please place your order well in advance. There are two ways to order tickets:

- You can order tickets on the Kehila Chadasha website, <u>www.e-kehila.org</u> (payment by *credit card or PayPal*). You can also list names for the Yizkor scroll and make tzedakah contributions on the website. Or,
- You can order tickets, list names for the Yizkor scroll and make tzedakah contributions using the enclosed paper forms (payment by *check* only).

We will mail your tickets to you as long as we receive your order by **Friday**, **September 4**<sup>th</sup>. Tickets for orders received after that date can be picked up at services at "Will Call."

Your donation defrays the cost of the services and supports the ongoing work of Rabbi Shneyer in the larger Jewish community. As you may know, his diverse activities enrich Jewish life and promote an inclusive Jewish philosophy, human rights, social justice, and collaboration between Jews and non-Jews.

In order to meet the demands of rising overhead costs and to keep the suggested contribution rate reasonably low, we have adopted these practices for accepting contributions.

- High Holiday tickets are available either for each individual holiday or for both holidays.
- Special rates are available for seniors, college students and young adults.
- If you feel your financial circumstances do not permit you to make the suggested contribution, use the enclosed paper order form.

**Kehila Chadasha Members**: If you are a current member, tickets for the adult services for your immediate family will be mailed to you. To request tickets for the Children's Services, or additional tickets for adult children, relatives or friends, go online to <u>www.e-kehila.org</u> or use the paper form. Please also consider making additional tzedakah contributions.

**Am Kolel Members:** If you are a current, *Full Household* dues paying member, two (2) tickets for each holiday will be mailed to you by Am Kolel. If you are a dues paying *Full Individual* member, one (1) ticket for each holiday will be mailed to you. If you are an *Associate* member or if you need <u>additional</u> tickets, please fill out the paper form sent to you by Am Kolel, or purchase tickets online at the Am Kolel website, <u>www.am-kolel.org</u>. # Children's Services Monday, September 14, 2015 (Rosh Hashanah) and Wednesday, September 23, 2015 (Yom Kippur)

Kehila Chadasha is once again pleased to offer an experiential High Holiday program for children. Our unique programs integrate worship, music and art. The children experience the joy and meaning of the holidays through these special, hands-on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur activities. Healthy snacks will be served both mornings and the children will have an opportunity to join the adult service to hear the blowing of the Shofar.

NOTE: Given the nature of the program, it would be ideal if your child arrives at 9:45 AM.

**NOTE:** There will be no children's program during the evening services on Rosh Hashanah and Kol Nidre. If you choose to bring your children, they must be able to sit quietly through the services.

Enrollment for children's services is on a first-come, first-served basis and spaces are limited. Please register **by September 12**<sup>th</sup> either on the website at <u>www.e-kehila.org</u> or by using the enclosed paper form.

#### The Essentials:

**Ages:** <u>Younger than 5 years</u> – accompanied by a parent or familiar adult who remains with the child throughout the program.

5 - 6 year-olds who do not require parental supervision – with a parent or familiar adult checking once every hour.

<u>7 - 12 year-olds</u> – can be unaccompanied.

Or, you can submit the names on the enclosed form and mail it to us (please print clearly). We ask that you include only the names of immediate family members.
