Band Book

The band book for all elementary schools is titled **Sound Innovations, Book 1.** Books must be provided by parents and are available online

or at local music stores.

Music books are specific for each instrument. Please be sure to purchase Book 1 for your student's chosen instrument.

Band Practices

Band classes are typically held once per week for 30-40 minutes. Band is a "pull out" program, so students will leave their normal classrooms to meet with their band teacher for music instruction. In order to be successful in band, all students must do the following:

- Make up any missed class work while attending band.
- Do all their homework.
- Maintain at least a "C" in every subject.
- Follow all school rules.

Failure to do so may result in their classroom teacher pulling them out of the band program.

Band students must also attend all band practices in order to be successful on their instrument. Attendance is extremely important!

Students are also required to practice a <u>minimum</u> of 15 minutes every day at home. **Parent supervision and encouragement is helpful for student success.** Monthly practice charts are issued at the start of every month to keep track of their practice and progress.

<u>Daily practice at home is required and essential to be successful on any instrument.</u>

Being a member of an elementary school band can be an exciting and educational experience! Band members learn cooperation, self-discipline, and listening skills all in the process of learning a musical instrument. Success of the elementary band member depends on the following items:

RESPONSIBILITY

- Obey all school rules.
- Maintain at least a "C" average in classroom subjects.
- Show all letters, permission slips, practice records, and band report cards to parents promptly.

ATTENDANCE

- Students must attend all band classes with instrument, music book, and supplies.
- Three unexcused absences in band will lower the band grand one letter.
- Four or more unexcused absences will result in student being removed from band.
- Students must inform band teacher of any absences due to illness, testing, special class presentations, or any other special circumstances.

PRACTICE

- Fifteen minutes of practice each day is required.
- Practice records will be sent home and must be returned each month, signed by parent or guardian.
- Weekly band assignments and homework will be given each week in band.

BEHAVIOR & BAND RULES

- Come in <u>quickly</u> and <u>quietly</u>.
- Keep all food and candy outside.
- Raise your hand to speak.
- Play your instrument only when asked by the teacher.
- Respect each other and each other's property.

CONSEQUENCES

- Verbal warning
- Rapid exit from band class
- Parent contact and/or suspension from band class
