WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:

This workshop will provide participants with a general overview of Facilitated Communication (FC), a method of augmentative and alternative communication used by people with limited speaking abilities and motor planning challenges. Topics covered will include the history of FC, understanding the method and misconceptions about it, basic elements of the FC technique, determining who might benefit from the method, and a review of current research and best practices. Examples and demonstrations of the use of FC with both school-age individuals and adults will be provided. This workshop will provide information to people who are interested in gaining basic understanding in FC and opening the doors to self-expression. It is also a prerequisite training for people who will become facilitators for individuals who use FC.
