How is my honoraria calculated?

- If your meeting plus travel time is five hours or less, you will be paid the hourly rate.
- If your meeting plus travel time is greater than five hours, you will be paid the per diem honoraria rate.
- If you sit on multiple committees, your highest hourly/per diem rate will be paid for all committee meetings you attend.

Do I need to attach expense receipts?

Yes, receipts must be attached for expenses to be reimbursed.

What if I would like my payment to go to my professional corporation?

The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) is not prepared to provide a formal ruling; however, based on discussions with them, it has been determined that, with the exception of payments for board work, honoraria payments are not considered income from an office and can be paid to either an individual or a professional corporation (PC).

If you want your payments to go to your PC, you'll need to complete a *PC Designation Form*. Once you've completed a *PC Designation* form, all honoraria and expenses will be paid to your PC.

Will I receive a T4 or T4A?

All honoraria paid to you personally will be reported annually on a T4A. Income paid to your PC will not be reported; however, you are still required to report the income on your corporate tax return.

Under the Income Tax Act, honoraria paid for board work must be paid to an individual. Honoraria payments for board work will have appropriate tax and Canada Pension Plan (CPP) deductions withheld and will be reported annually on a T4.

A Social Insurance Number will be required to process your T4 and/or T4A.

Does GST get added to my honoraria if I'm registered for GST?

Yes, if you've registered for GST you will need to complete a *GST Registration Form*. Once the form has been completed, GST will be automatically added to your honoraria payments.
