IF YOU DON'T HAVE A NYS DRIVER LICENSE OR NON-DRIVER ID

Dear Applicant,

Your new photo identification card from the Department of State will be manufactured by the NYS Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). To do this, DMV must have a picture of you on file.

- >> If you already have a valid NYS Driver License or Non-Driver ID with photo, please refer back to your Department of State application for instructions.
- >> If you do not have a valid NYS Driver License or Non-Driver ID with photo, you must visit a DMV office to have your picture taken. Bring this letter and proof of your name, date of birth, and signature. After reviewing your proofs, a DMV representative will take your picture and give you a receipt. Your receipt will show a 9-digit ID number assigned by DMV. Write that number on your Department of State application.

If you wish, you may apply for a NYS Non-Driver ID card while you have your picture taken at the DMV office. The ID card is available for a small fee and is widely accepted throughout the United States as a valid form of personal identification.

In either case, review the customer's proof(s) of name, date of birth & signature. Indicate the proofs provided by check-marking the lists on this letter. Print the customer's name, DOB and sex on the blanks at the upper right. Staple the office copy of the FS-6T to this letter and the MV-44 (if necessary). Add to your batch paperwork as usual.

Please instruct the customer to save his or her copy of the FS-6T. The Client ID indicated on the FS-6T will be required on the customer's application to the Department of State. Requests for assistance with the Department of State application should be referred to the Department of State.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Before DMV can take your photo, you must provide 6 points of proof of name, and proof of date of birth. All proofs must be original documents or documents certified by the agency that issued them. At least one proof must show your signature. Photocopies are not acceptable. Documents of the same type count as only one proof (for example, two or more credit cards count as only one credit card).

PROOF OF DATE OF BIRTH - ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS ONLY - PHOTOCOPIES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE

- U.S. Birth Certificate: Issued by a Board of Health, Bureau of Vital Statistics, or U.S. State Department. Foreign Birth Certificates are **not** acceptable. Must be an original document or a document certified by the issuing agency.

- U.S. Passports
- Foreign Passport (with INS Documentation)
- Immigration Documents
