Riverview uses OpenDNS content filtering to help maintain a safe and secure digital information environment. Additionally, the school can monitor student use of the Internet. However, content filtering cannot block 100% of inappropriate or controversial material. Students will be under teacher supervision at all times when accessing the Internet.
