Basic Civil Mediation Training

The course fee is \$995 if paid in full on or prior to January 15, 2015 and \$1,195 if paid in full thereafter. Prior to January 15, 2015 you may reserve your space by paying a non-refundable \$200 deposit. The remainder of the course fee for those who have made deposits must be made by January 15, 2015 or you risk losing your reserved spot. New registrations made on or after January 15, 2015 must be paid in full. Course fee includes all meals, snacks and course materials (except the course textbook).
