Who Can Apply to Bay College?

Any student who has graduated from high school, or who has obtained a General Education Diploma (GED), or who is at least 18 years of age is eligible for admission. Admission to Bay de Noc Community College does not ensure placement in all courses or programs. Many courses have prerequisites, and some programs have additional requirements.

How Do I Apply?

- 1. Complete the Application for Admission.
- Provide placement scores (ACT or COMPASS). Scores must be within last past three years.

Note: If you have taken classes at Bay College within the past three years, you do not need to re-apply for admission.

High School Seniors: High school transcripts are required for current high school seniors interested in being considered for fall scholarships to Bay College.

Transfer Students: Official college transcripts must be sent directly to Bay College Admissions.

Guest Students: Students currently enrolled in another college/university who are interested in taking a Bay College course for transfer back to their home institution should apply as a guest student. Obtain a Michigan Uniform Guest Application online at www.macrao.org.

Dual Enrolled High School Students: Students are encouraged to work with their high school for eligibility requirements.

Re-Admit Students: If it has been over three years since you last attended classes at Bay College, you must re-apply for admission.
