



## ADA CAMP CAREFREE CAMPER CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST

*Please fill out this list and place it in camper's trunk or suitcase. Check items off at the end of camp when you come for your camper!*

### **BECAUSE OF LIMITED SPACE, PLEASE PACK EFFICIENTLY & SEND ONLY WHAT IS ON THE LIST**

For everyday use at camp, bring old clothes suitable for a camping environment. Enough clothing should be brought for **TWO** weeks with the understanding that there are **NO LAUNDRY FACILITIES AT CAMP.**

Please use nametags or indelible markers to identify all clothing. **ALL BELONGINGS MUST BE MARKED WITH CAMPER'S NAME.** Trunks, suitcases or multi-drawer storage chests are recommended and must have camper's name and address attached. Camp Carefree cannot be responsible for anything lost, destroyed or left at camp. In the event something IS left at camp after closing day---**WE CANNOT MAIL THE ITEMS BACK TO YOU!** This would be a tremendous expense to the camp, and we WILL NOT send lost items back to you!

**\*\*\*If your child has not yet learned to write letters/address envelopes: we suggest that you send self-addressed stamped envelopes with them to camp! Postcards should also be self-addressed and stamped. Doing this, would be a huge help to the counselors!!**

Spending Money: for stamps, Trading Post, pictures, etc. may be left at the Bank/Trading Post at check in on Opening Day. Most people ask how much to leave. We find that anywhere from \$25-40 is sufficient for the two week stay. Please remember, that if your child "goes over" their account, you will be asked to pay the balance on Closing Day. Also remember, that all one-way e-mails will also be billed to your camper's account. There is a rate of .35 cents per e-mail. Please see "Info for Parents" for more information! **NO CASH SHOULD BE LEFT WITH THE CAMPER!**

On Opening Day, t-shirts will be made available for purchase at \$10.00-\$12.00 each, as well as a variety of other items from our Trading Post store.

**NOT ALLOWED: The following items are NOT allowed and will be taken for the duration of camp: swim fins, masks and snorkels, food, knives, axes, all cutting tools, cigarettes (SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED ON CAMP GROUNDS) or drugs/alcohol of any kind, cell phones, radios, IPODS, CDs, electronic games, skateboards, rollerblades, hairdryers, curling irons, etc. Not only can this equipment be distracting, but can easily be broken or lost.**

**ADA CAMP CAREFREE provides ALL insulin & diabetes supplies, EXCEPT PUMP SUPPLIES & PUMP BATTERIES AS WELL AS TYPE 2 DIABETES MEDICATIONS. For those on pumps, please pack supplies in a Rubbermaid-type container with your child's name clearly labeled. ALL other medications MUST be given to the Medical Staff upon arrival at camp, during check-in.**

**PLEASE REMEMBER TO LABEL ALL OF YOUR CHILD'S BELONGINGS!!**

**Please also note: we DO NOT RETURN any items to your child after camp ends! This would be very costly—so PLEASE be sure to check everything on Closing Day of camp**
