Rationale

High school students' experience with college-level curricula has been found to be a predictor of success in higher education. An analysis has found that Dickinson High students are taking advantage of Advanced Placement (AP) course offerings less frequently than their peers in comparable schools. Out of 2000 students in 2011-12, 300 successfully completed at least one AP class.

Administrator Goal

During the 2013-14 school year, 340 students (40 more than in 2011-12) will successfully complete an AP course as measured by:

- A. score of 3, 4, or 5 on the AP test and
- B. A course grade of C or better.

Baseline Data

Baseline Data consisted of AP course participation levels, test scores, and course grades from 2011-12 and 2012-13.
