Students, who are awarded the scholarship, will become part of a learning community, and participate with their peers in an intensive, multi-faceted two year experience, rarely available to community college students. **The scholarship is worth \$2,500 per year for two years.**

Requirements

- Minimum 2.5 cumulative high school grade point average (GPA);
- Planned full-time enrollment in a transfer track program: Associate of Arts or Associate of Science;
- Minimum ACT scores of – English – 18, Reading – 17, Mathematics – 19; or SAT scores of – Verbal (English) – 440, Verbal (Reading) – 430, Mathematics – 460. Alternatively, students can take the Accuplacer (or other equivalent college placement exam) to establish preparedness for college-level course work.
- Can NOT be participating in college athletics (LOI, redshirt, walk-on)
- U.S. Citizen
