# Spring Speakers April 3 • James Bennett • Illustrator

James Bennett began his professional career shortly after receiving recognition from the Society of Illustrators as a scholarship student at the School of Visual Arts in New York.

James Bennett's conceptually humorous illustrations have since appeared as covers and interior pieces for the New York Times, the L. A. Times, Forbes, Time, Sports Illustrated, The Weekly Standard, Mad, Business Week, New York, Smithsonian, Reader's Digest, Yankee, Golf and Philadelphia magazines, among others. He has also produced art for RCA Records American Express, Paramount pictures, Citibank, Hasbro, and Milton Bradley.

James Bennett has recently completed a number of picture books two of which have appeared in the top 5 of the New York Times Best Seller list. They are "Tell Me a Scary Story...But Not Too Scary", written by Carl Reiner and the picture book "Halloween", written by Jerry Seinfeld.

James Bennett's awards include the prestigious Hamilton King, which acknowledges an illustrator's outstanding body of work represented by the Best Illustration of the Year by a Member, the Steven Dohanos Award from Society of Illustrators in New York. The Creative Show in San Diego which recognized the best in advertising for the year, awarded him a gold medal, and he has also won gold medals from the Society of Illustrators Annual Shows in New York City. Bennett has recently been featured in an issue of Communication Arts. His oils can be found in the Howard Gallery in New Hope, Pennsylvania.

A member of the Executive Board of Directors at the Society of Illustrators, Bennett is also active in the Illustrators Partnership of America. 1. Properly wired and <u>framed</u> for handling and hanging. Anything other than properly wired and framed will not be accepted.

2. Properly labeled with name, address, title and price. Not for Sale is allowed. No additional labels or signs will be allowed.

3. Under 36" for hanging work, including frame. Under 200 lbs. and 6' limit for sculpture.

4. All work exhibited must be original and sole work of the artist and cannot have been exhibited at any previous DAL Show .

5.While every care will be taken to ensure the safety of the submitted works of art, the Doylestown Art League and the exhibition venues will not be responsible for any loss of or damage to the artwork.

6. It is the artists responsibility to check the printed program for accuracy.

7. Prizes will be awarded only if there is a sufficient number of entries in a category.

8. Membership dues must be paid; dues may be paid the day of delivery

9.Show Patrons are encouraged, appreciated and usually necessary to meet costs. For those wishing to participate, submit your gift the day of delivery or send prior to April 10, 2013 to D.A.L. c/o Bernard Vieille, 1524 Turk Rd., Warrington, PA 18976.
