BUS SAFETY FOR STUDENTS Parents/Guardians, student drop-offs and pick-ups must be from the designated parent parking area ONLY. When this is

followed, no student will step into the pathway of any vehicle. Do not use the street in front of the school or the bus parking lane if there are any buses parked there. We do not want the students to be walking or running between parked buses or cars driving through the zone. The buses are big and visibility of students and unauthorized vehicles is limited and there is a lot of activity in these areas, especially at the beginning and ending of the school day. Also, when vehicles are parked on the street the buses are not able to turn onto the roadway.

Student safety is our number 1 concern. Please make it yours.

BLANKET STUDENT ACCIDENT POLICY Prairie Spirit provides accident insurance through Industrial Alliance Insurance that provides insurance coverage if your child has an accident at school during the school day. Children are also covered if the accident occurs at a time when they are involved in any extra-curricular activities before or after school hours, including school trips. In the unfortunate circumstances of needing this insurance, the school will need to be notified of the accident immediately so that they can submit an incident report to the insurance company and provide the parent or guardian with a claim form. The parent or guardian will need to pay any expenses initially, then ask the appropriate medical authority to complete and sign the form. The parent will then submit the form directly to Alliance Insurance. The claim process is between the parent or guardian and the insurance company. Industrial Alliance Insurance does offer additional KidsPlus Accident Insurance should you wish to purchase it. Details can be found in the KidsPlus Accident Insurance Package.
