NCAA Bylaw 11.2.2 requires that all full- or part-time Eastern Michigan University Athletic Department staff members (excluding secretarial or clerical) must provide an annual detailed accounting to the chief executive officer of all athletically-related income and benefits received from sources OUTSIDE Eastern Michigan University. These types of income and benefits include:

- (a) Income from annuities;
(b) Sports camps;
(c) Housing benefits (including preferential housing arrangements);
(d) Country club memberships;
(e) Complimentary ticket sales;
(f) Television and radio programs; and
(g) Endorsement or consultation contracts with athletics shoe, apparel or equipment manufacturers.

Do NOT list any income or benefits provided by the university (e.g., complimentary tickets), or anything that is included in a university employment agreement/contract (e.g., country club membership, etc..)
