Presidents Message



RED RIBBON WEEK

Community Unit School District 95, in conjunction with its Parent Teacher Organizations and community members, is actively participating in the 2015 observance of *Red Ribbon Week*, October 26-30th. Red Ribbon Week started as the result of the tragic death of Drug Enforcement Agent Enrique "Kiki" Camarena in 1985. The color red and the 'Red Ribbon' have been the symbol of this national campaign since it officially began in 1988. The Red Ribbon is a symbol for Americans to show that ribbon by ribbon, neighbor by neighbor, we are united in our stand for a drug-free youth. With more than 100,000 schools and organizations taking part, Red Ribbon Week is the largest anti-drug awareness event in the United States.

During our Red Ribbon Week Kick-off on Monday October 26, students and teachers will be decorating school property with red ribbons. We encourage you, as members of our community, to actively participate at home by displaying the red ribbon provided by the Ela Coalition Against Youth Substance Abuse, the Lake County Health Department and the Illinois Dept of Human Services.

*Elementary Students are encouraged to participate in the Coloring Contest to express their commitment to make healthy choices. Grade level winners will be chosen and will be displayed in schools. Coloring pages will be sent home October 22nd. All entries are due October 26th.
