


Fr. Michael White, Rebuilt Co-Author



**Father Michael White** is a priest of the Baltimore Archdiocese, where he served as an archdiocesan Vice-Chancellor; as Priest-Secretary to (then-Archbishop) Cardinal William Keeler and, during that time, as director of Pope John Paul II's visit to Baltimore.

Fr. White is presently Pastor at the Church of the Nativity in Timonium, Md., which has seen the congregation nearly triple in weekend attendance and a significant increase of giving and service in ministry. Fr. White is also co-author of "Rebuilt," which narrates the story of Nativity Church's rebirth.

**Brian Crook** is the Director of Missions at Church of the Nativity. He grew up in Timonium, Maryland and has witnessed Church of the Nativity's transformation to a thriving parish through the years. He received his bachelor's degree from Furman University and has served on staff at Nativity for the past six years. Brian oversees Nativity's local and global Missions strategic partnerships as well as leads the Adult Discipleship department.
