California Law (AB 1806) provides that pupils who have been identified as McKinney Vento and/or Foster Youth who transfer high schools after the pupil's second year of high school are exempted from all coursework and other requirements adopted by the governing board of the school district in which s/he is enrolled. This is in addition to the Statewide coursework requirements specified in Sections 51225.3, unless the school district makes a finding that the pupil is reasonably able to complete the school district's graduation requirements in time to graduate from high school by the end of the pupil's fourth year of high school. If the school district finds that the pupil could meet the district's graduation requirements within the pupil's fifth year of the high school, the district must inform the pupil of his or her option to remain for a fifth year to complete the district's graduation requirements.

The District has determined that your eligibility for this exemption is as follows:

- You **are eligible for this exemption*** and may obtain a high school diploma by meeting the state-mandated graduation requirements.
- You will be able to meet the additional requirements the District requires before the end of your 4th year of high school; therefore, *you **are not eligible for this exemption at this time***. If you believe that this conclusion is in error, a reevaluation of your eligibility may be completed upon your request. Contact your school counselor if you would a reevaluation.
- You will be able to meet the additional requirements the District requires with an options fifth (5th) year of high school. You have the option to remain for a 5th year of high school to meet the District's Board-adopted graduation requirements.

If you choose to be exempted from the District's additional graduation requirements, your ability to gain admission to a post-secondary educational institution may be affected. In order to meet the admission requirements for the California State University or University of California campuses, specific college preparatory courses are required for freshman admission, which are more extensive and rigorous than the state's minimum graduation requirements. In addition, California Community Colleges provide the opportunity for students to complete freshman and sophomore level classes that are transferable to a four-year university.
