 allocated to those organizations who apply earliest. Allocation of sponsorship packages and
 booths regardless of the preference indicated, and the alteration of the floor plan is at the
 discretion of the Conference Planning Committee, whose decision will be final.
- Sponsorship Applications must be received by May 1, 2015 for consideration.
- On receipt of the Sponsorship Application, a confirmation letter will be sent highlighting further information regarding benefits, due dates, an invoice, etc.
- Once a Sponsorship Application has been received and confirmed, any cancellation must be
 advised in writing to the Department of Education c/o Adult Education and Literacy. If the
 cancellation is received up to two (2) months before the event an administration fee of 25% of
 the total price will be charged.
- If the cancellation is received less than two (2) months prior, no refund is applicable.
