Guidance Notes for the Completion of this Application

1. This application must be signed by a company director or authorised representative of the registered owner company. A list of directors of the registered owner company must be supplied.

A Power of Attorney/Evidence of Authority must be supplied if not the beneficial owner or a director of the registered owner company. The POA should specify the following:

- The authority to de-register the aircraft on behalf of the registered owner;
- Include aircraft registration mark, manufacturer's designation of aircraft and serial number.
- Be dated prior to the date on this Form SM 11.

2. All invoices must be settled with CAA SMR prior to de-registration.

3. Return the Certificate of Registration and any other certificates/approvals issued by the CAA SMR to:

4. Once the aircraft will be de-registered a confirmation will be sent to the new state of registry and copied to the registered owner or their representative.
5. If the aircraft remains in the CAA SMR once the transfer of ownership takes place, the new owner is required to fill a new FORM SM 01 | Application for Certificate of Registration and submit it along with supporting documents as outlined in Section 4.1 of the Civil Aviation Publication (CAP) 01 to commence the re-registration process.
