

PSI/PTO Baile Folklorico Dance
2015-16 Permission Waiver / Code of Conduct

I give my child, _____, permission to participate in Baile Folklorico dance at Park Spanish Immersion during the 2015-16 school year.

I understand this is an after school activity in which students dance at PSI/Central (classrooms, cafeteria, gym, etc).

I have discussed with my child his/her role in terms of behavior including, but not limited to, listening to the Dance Instructor, PSI Staff, Parent Leads; speaking Spanish, participating in a positive way and demonstrating a high level of respect for themselves, their peers, all persons affiliated with the program and our school and facilities.

Should my child become a disruption that hinders the ability of the instructor to teach, I will work with the Dance Leadership Team to put a plan in place to rectify the situation immediately.

As parents and the Dance Leadership team work together around behavior issues, the following steps will be taken:

- Offense 1: Instructor will have student "take a break"
- Offense 2: Instructor will notify a member of the Dance Leadership Team and they will contact parent with a request that parent review expected behavior (see 3rd paragraph above)
- Offense 3: Parent will be asked to attend the next practice

If disruptive behavior continues, parent may be asked to continue attending practice. If that doesn't solve issues, student can be asked to forfeit his/her spot in the program.

I will not hold PSI, the PSI PTO or District 283 responsible for any accidental injuries that result from this after school activity.

I have discussed with my child to leave his/her coat, hat, backpack and all other personal items, with the exception of a water bottle and snack, in his/her locker to reduce the potential spread of head lice.

I have discussed the importance of regular attendance and will notify Maria Reyes at reyes.maria@slpschools.org or 952-848-5508 if my child cannot attend due to illness or conflict with another school activity.

I have discussed with my child where they are to go after dance and/or who is picking them up.
