

# Download eBooks and eAudiobooks to Your Tablet or Mobile Device via the OverDrive app

(iOS, Android, Kindle, Nook, and Windows)

## For ePUB formatted eBooks and mp3 Audiobooks:

### Here's what you'll need to get started:

- Your **Glenview Public Library card**
- The **OverDrive® app** (installed from the app store for your device—see below)
- After installing the app, you will be asked to create an **OverDrive® account**. Follow the prompt to type in an email address and password. This will allow you to sync the eBooks and Audiobooks you have checked out across different devices.

### Steps for searching and downloading books:

1. Open the **OverDrive** app.
2. Tap on the **Home Menu** icon in the upper left corner of the screen.
3. Tap on **Add a Library** and type in zip code 60025.
4. On the next screen, tap the star in front of **MyMediaMall** to save it as your preferred collection. Now touch this **MyMediaMall** link to open it and begin to search for books.
5. Sign In (upper right hand corner) to your account using your **Glenview Public Library card number**.
6. Search the collection for an **eBook** (in **ePUB** format) or an **eAudiobook** (in **mp3** format), then tap **Borrow** to check it out.. If it is not available for checkout, tap **Place a Hold** and you will be notified by email when the title is available for checkout.
7. Once you have checked out an item, your library **Bookshelf** will open, displaying the title you have checked out.
8. Tap **Download**, select the format you wish to download, and tap **Confirm & Download**.
