## WESTERN PERFORMANCE HORSE SALE TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The standard Australian Livestock & Property Agents Association Ltd (ALPA) terms and conditions for livestock sale apply to livestock sales made at the AQHA Western Performance Horse Sale. A copy of the ALPA terms and conditions will be available at the Tamworth branch of Landmark and during the AQHA Western Performance Horse Sale.

The Owner of the horse must be a financial membership of the AQHA and the Registration Certificate must be issued in that Owners name.

All Sale horses must be on the grounds by 12 noon Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2013, as inspection by the AQHA of all sale horses must be completed on this day and will commence at 12 noon. Sale horses must be presented to the satisfaction of the appointed inspector. The inspector may reject a horse from the sale if the horse does not comply with the following conditions.

- (a) Markings and hair whorls and/or brands described on the AQHA registration papers must be clearly visible and identical to the horse presented for inspection.
- (b) The horse should be prepared and presented suitably for the sale.
- (c) The horse should be free of undesirable characteristics and conformation faults.
- (d) Where the vendor has retained semen or embryos, then the Vendor must have organised Semen or Embryo Permits with the AQHA, prior to the sale this fact must also be disclosed by the vendor to the Auctioneer prior to the sale of the lot. The Auctioneer will disclose these facts at the time of sale.
- (e) Random drug testing may be carried out on sale day.

Entry form must be completed in full and received at the AQHA Office by close of business 5pm Friday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2013 together with full payment of \$220.00 and photo of sale horse otherwise the entry will not be accepted.

Commission on the sale price is 7% + GST of the Sale Gross, this will be payable by the vendor to the Auctioneer in respect to each lot catalogued and sold. This commission is payable in full on the day of sale, whether sold at Auction or private treaty. AQHA reserves the right to restrict the number of entries.

Owners are advised that in line with AQHA rules on prohibited substances in horses that random drug tests may be carried out for lots consigned to the sale both prior to sale and following that lot having been offered for sale. Positive results from this testing would result in any catalogued lot being disqualified from sale and any monetary terms will then become null and void.

Purchasers reserve the right to request pre sale x-rays of specific lots they may be interested in purchasing, however these must be performed the day prior to sale and at the prospective purchasers expense.

Any information supplied on the nomination form that is found to be inaccurate or misleading may result in immediate disqualification from the sale and the nomination fee will be forfeited. Any owner discovered misrepresenting a sale horse does so at the risk of being charged with a federal offence.

The AQHA reserves the right to edit/alter catalogue notes.

Once the horse has been accepted into the catalogue, the nomination fee is non-refundable if the horse is withdrawn.

All horses offered for sale must have all required genetic testing results (as per AQHA rule book) on file with the AQHA prior to nomination

Nominations with pending registrations will not be accepted! Any horse accepted as a colt cannot be sold as a gelding.

- Sale nominations may consist of the following - Weanlings, Yearlings, 2 Year Olds and older
- A maximum age of 15 years apply to broodmares and they must be a minimum of 45 days positively pregnancy tested in foal or have a foal at foot when presented for sale.
- All Mares, sold with foal at foot, must also send in the foals Application for Registration form with the Nomination Form. All mares being sold in foal, must lodge a PTIF Certificate with the Nomination. If neither of these documents is available, the mare will not be accepted for Nomination.
- Two year olds and over must either be broken in or led through the sale.

### **IMPORTANT - Landmark Equine Drug Policy**

All horses being offered at the Q13 AQHA Western Performance Horse Sale are offered subject to a **No Prohibited Substance** rule (unless accompanied by a current vet certificate stating that the horse has been treated for a minor injury with analgesics or anti-inflammatory drugs\*).

This means that no Prohibited Substance is to be administered to the horse in the time before the sale such that it, or any ingredient or metabolism of it, might be present in the horse, might be detectable in its blood, saliva and/or urine samples, or might have any effect on its performance at the time of the sale.

- In relation to the Q13 AQHA Western Performance Horse Sale the purchaser or selling Agent, at the fall of the auctioneer's hammer, may request a swab or sample be taken from the subject horse at the expense of the purchaser, so requesting. If the purchaser so elects, the sale of the swabbed horse may be rendered null and void if the horse returns a positive swab to any prohibited substance.
- Any substance is a "prohibited substance" if it contains an ingredient that is a stimulant, depressant, tranquilliser, local anaesthetic, psychotropic (mood and/or behaviour altering) substance, or drug which might affect the performance of the horse and might interfere with the prohibited substance testing process.
- In the event of a sale horse returning a positive test to any banned substance, the vendor and or any handler or interested party will be banned from entering a horse into any Landmark conducted horse sale for a period of 5 years.
- By entering a horse in the Q13 AQHA Western Performance Horse Sale, you hereby agree that your horse may be selected at random for testing for any prohibited substance. The findings from these tests will be displayed on the AQHA and the Landmark-Classic website within fourteen days of the date of sale.
- Any certificate must include a statement that the horse is fit for sale, the reason the drug has been given, the drug administered, the dose, the route of administration and the date and time the last dose was administered. A certificate must be dated within 7 days of the sale date and must be received at the Q13 AQHA Western Performance Horse Sale office no later than 10.00am on Thursday, 11<sup>th</sup> April 2013.

Vendor is to guarantee 100% soundness with a cooling off period of 7 days post sale date.
