Take US 72 East towards Scottsboro, take the AL 35 exit. Go approx 13 miles on AL 35 and turn right onto Co Rd 100. Travel approx 2 miles, North East Alabama Hunting Preserve will be on your right.

From

Chattanooga,

Take I59 South to Ft Payne. Take exit 218 and turn right onto AL 35. Go 13 miles and turn left onto Co Rd 100. Travel approx 2 miles, North East Alabama Hunting Preserve will be on your right.

From Birmingham,

take I59 North to Ft Payne. Take exit 218 and turn left onto AL 35. Go 13 miles and turn left onto Co Rd 100. Travel approx 2 miles, North East Alabama Hunting Preserve will be on your right.
