ADVENT MASS: Year 3 will be leading the whole school Advent Mass on Thursday 4th December at 9.15am everyone is welcome to join as we start our Advent journey.

ADVENT REFLECTION: We will be holding reflections sessions during Advent at which the children can take time to reflect and pray together. These will take place on the three Wednesday's during December at 9.05am in the hall; everyone is welcome to join us.
