Part #1-Only the On-line Classroom \$175.00

Student must be 15 years old to begin the Classroom/On-line on-line course.
Please allow 7-10 days for a Priority Mail On-line package to be delivered to you with Instructions, passwords and text book.
The On-line/ Classroom part only is NOT eligible for the Wisconsin State Form-MV3001 for obtaining a temporary permit.
CESA #2 will issue a classroom letter of completion to present to the "Behind the Wheel Provider".

Part #2 -Only Behind the Wheel \$250.00

Student must be enrolled either in the On-line course or completed classroom part of driver education program.
Student must be 15 years and six months old to obtain an instructional permit from the State of Wisconsin. Once registration and payment are received, the MV3001 form will be sent to the student's home. The MV3001 form must be presented to the DMV along with the student's original birth certificate and the student's social security card or passport to obtain the instructional permit.

Behind the Wheel (BTW) instruction is scheduled on an individual bases after the student has obtained the Instructional Permit
