Acceptance into the TV99 intern program is a privilege. Students are recommended at the school level and are screened based on their teacher's & fellow students' recommendations, quality of reel and/or script, and thoughtfulness of answers provided on the application. Acceptance is also dependent on the ability to coordinate their schedules so that they can attend during a block with available space – A3, A4, B3 or B4.

The application deadline is May 20, 2011 and must be accompanied by:

One :30 promo script (promote your school, sports team, club, TV99) and/or

One miniDV, DVD or URL featuring samples of your: on-air presence, videography, editing or graphics

Commitment is an essential part of the learning process, and without it, the student's internship will be halted. In return, students will receive hands-on, quality time immersed in all aspects of professional television production. If your son or daughter is considering a career in communications, the internship provides him/her with the opportunity to begin building a resume' that can help with college admissions or future employment.
