### CHEQUES FOR ENTRIES MADE PAYABLE TO: WRESSAA

Tendering an NSF cheque is considered non-payment of entry fees and may be subject to disciplinary action by the CKC. A \$25.00 service charge will be assessed to any NSF cheques. Cheques post-dated after closing are not acceptable.

The Club will refund entry, service charge, and listing fee where a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Agility Trial Secretary. A veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial.

**PLEASE NOTE:** As of January 1, 1993 **ALL ENTRIES** must be on the official CKC Entry Form or a copy thereof. If you wish to submit entries on a computerized form it must be of the same size and format as the one issued by CKC and must bear the CKC Logo as per the enclosed entry forms. No exceptions will be made.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Entries will be acknowledged after closing date. Receipts, judging schedules and Exhibitors Passes will be mailed.
2. Entry fees shall not be refunded after the closing date in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly.
3. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
4. (Chapter 8, Section 8, CKC Dog Show Rules) "A Judge officiating at a dog show held under these rules shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
5. **All dogs and children must be kept under control at all times.**
6. Dogs must be exercised in designated areas only. Please pick-up after your dogs.
7. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
8. The classes will be held outdoors rain or shine.
9. The precincts of the show are defined as 10' from edge of rings at SHOULDICE ATHLETIC PARK.
10. Camping and RV parking will be available on the Show Grounds.
11. Additional entry forms may be photocopied.
12. A veterinarian will be within easy access. (Contact AKC Show Desk.)
13. Dog Show Rule books, Obedience Trial & Agility Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6 + GST per copy.
14. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to these trials.

## ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC Registration Number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN Number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or Visa/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholders' name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN number to you. Cost \$58.85 (Canadian). ERN NUMBER MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE FIRST DAY OF HAVING ENTERED A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca>.

**PAYMENT:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank draft or money order payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

**Canada-USA Border Crossing:** A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog.

## CLASSES OFFERED

### Regular Standard Classes:

Novice Class "A"	For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country with any organization. A dog that has met the requirements for a Novice title, may continue to compete in the Novice A class in those trials that have been previously entered providing the entries have closed. If the entries have not closed, the dog must be moved to Novice B.
Novice Class "B"	For agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and, for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any organization.
Intermediate Class	The Intermediate class is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice Title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.
Excellent Class "A"	The Excellent A class is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.
Excellent Class "B"	The Excellent B class is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title.
Exhibition Only	For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club

### Regular Jumpers With Weaves Classes:

Novice "A" Jumpers With Weaves	Novice Jumpers With Weaves A is for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or with any organization.
Novice "B" Jumpers With Weaves	Novice Jumpers With Weaves B is for agility instructors and Judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Novice Jumpers With Weaves title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Intermediate Jumpers With Weaves, and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any organization.
Intermediate Jumpers With Weaves Class	The Intermediate Jumpers With Weaves class is open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Jumpers With Weaves title, and to those dogs that have acquired the Intermediate Jumpers With Weaves Title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Excellent Jumpers With Weaves Title.
Excellent "A" Jumpers With Weaves Class	The Excellent Jumpers With Weaves A class is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate Jumpers With Weaves Title, but have not yet earned the Excellent Jumpers With Weaves Title.
Excellent "B" Jumpers With Weaves Class	The Excellent Jumpers With Weaves B class is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent Jumpers With Weaves title or the Master Excellent Jumpers With Weaves title.

### Selected Class:

The Selected Classes (both Standard & Jumpers With Weaves) follow the Agility Trials Rules & Regulations. The courses will be the same as in the Regular Classes but will have adjusted height and course times. Novice Select Class is not divided into A and B Divisions. The same rules apply for Excellent A & B as those described for the Regular Classes.

A dog must be entered only in Selected Class or in Regular Classes at the same set of trials. They may move back and forth between the two Classes but not at the same set of trials offered by a club on the same day or on consecutive days.

### Moving Up (ARR 6.8.1)

A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Miscellaneous Class Certification Number or a Performance Event Number (PEN) and has received 3 qualifying scores from a least 2 different judges, may be transferred to the next level provided that a written or electronic request is received not less than one hour prior to the commencement of each trial or in accordance with the conditions advertised in the premium list.

### **SAME DAY MOVE UPS WILL BE ALLOWED as per Rule 6.8.1**

### Height Divisions – Chapter 10

10.1.1 The following jump height divisions shall be used in all trial classes:

8" – for dogs 10" and under at the withers  
12" – for dogs over 10" up to and including 14"  
16" – for dogs over 14" up to and including 18"  
20" – for dogs over 18" up to and including 22"  
24" – for dogs over 22" at the withers

10.1.2 The following jump height divisions shall be used in all Selected classes:

4" – for dogs 10" and under at the withers  
8" – for dogs 14" and under at the withers  
12" – for dogs 18" and under at the withers  
16" – for dogs 22" and under at the withers  
20" – for dogs over 22" at the withers

8.4.5 Dogs entering the Selected Classes must progress through the various levels beginning with the Novice Level. A dog may continue to compete at each level until a qualifying score at the next higher level is earned.

### Exhibitor Information

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations. At the option of the handler, a dog may wear either a well-fitting plain buckle collar, a quick-release collar, or no collar. Fancy collars, choke collars, pinch collars, or other training collars are prohibited. Collars which are too tight or so large that they hang down unreasonably in front of the dog are not permitted. There shall be nothing hanging from the collar (12.3.1) Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other training devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course (12.1.1)

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

## PRIZE LIST

### ALL CLASSES AND LEVELS

Rosettes will be awarded for all qualifying scores.

Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1st-4th Place in each Height Division, provided the dog has earned a qualifying score. A Qualifying score is 85 points or more out of a possible 100 points, with NO NON-QUALIFYING DEDUCTIONS.

#### Rules For Parking
