Box 17, Safat 13001, State of Kuwait**, and must be accompanied by the appropriate registration fee according to the Kuwait Civil Aviation Safety Regulations Part 27. The fee may be paid by cheques/draft and made payable to the Directorate General of Civil Aviation with Central Bank of Kuwait.

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CONDITIONS:

1. If the aircraft has been registered in another state, a Certificate should be furnished from the competent authorities in the state of such registration that the registration is cancelled.
2. Fifteen working days should be allowed from receipt of registration application for the DGCA to process the application. An aircraft type/model which is not currently certified in the State of Kuwait may require special investigation with a consequential increase in time required.
3. The making of false statement for the purpose of procuring the issue of a certificate of registration is an offence under the Act 60 of 1960. The Directorate General of Civil Aviation may, in any case in which they think it is desirable, require the applicant for a certificate of registration to furnish such evidence as they may desire and to make and subscribe a statutory declaration as to the truth of the facts set out in the application.
4. Aircraft may be allocated any three letter sequence which is either not used, or has not previously been used, except for certain reserved groups of letters. Owners should note that the registration marks cannot be transferred from one aircraft to another. For details please contact the Aviation Safety Department. Our email address is safety@dgca.gov.kw.

Fees for Aircraft Registration

Aircraft having maximum weight not exceeding 750 kg.	12.500 KD.
Aircraft exceeding 750 kg. But not exceeding 15 tonnes	15.000 KD.
Aircraft exceeding 15 tonnes.	37.500 KD.
