
The Student Board meetings are at 12:00 p.m. in the Media Center (lunch is provided), followed by the PTSA Board Meeting at 1:00 p.m.

Students may enter in any of the following categories:




- Literature

Battle of the Bands November 19, 2015

The Utah PTA sponsors Battle of the Bands, a yearly event where bands from high schools across the state come together to compete for prizes. In past years, prizes included an opportunity to create a music video, studio time, CD's, performance time at the Salt Lake Arts Festival, and more.

The annual Layton High Battle of the Bands competition will be held in the auditorium at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 19th. All musical ensembles or groups (with a minimum of two members) are welcome to enter. One band will advance to the multi-region competition to represent Layton High School. The top three bands from each multi-region will advance to the State Battle of the Bands.

School Participation Rules

- Must have a 2.0 GPA or better.
- Must have good citizenship no U's.
- Must pay a \$10 entry fee.
- 60% of the group must currently be LHS students.
- You will need to play a set of 2 songs, one original song and one cover of a song from 1960present. The set will not be longer than 8 minutes playing time. There is a 10-minute time limit to get on stage, perform, and get off stage. Points will be deducted for going over time.
- Each band will submit a recording of your performance of both songs on a CD or zip drive by October 23rd, 2015. Must also submit a typed copy of the lyrics of both songs. All school rules for language and dress code will be enforced. Sound checks will start at 5:00 p.m. on November 19th.
- You will have half of the stage to set up and perform. The other half will be used for the next band.
- Judging will be partially audience votes and partially judges' assessment.

Those interested in competing in Battle of the Bands, please come to our first meeting, which will be held on **Thursday, October 1st at 2:20 p.m. in the Media Center**.
