1. Entrants must be **between the ages of 15 and 25 years** and ACT or NSW residents.
2. Artwork must be less than 2 years old and **not previously exhibited** in the ACT or surrounding region.
3. **All mediums** may be submitted for entry.
4. Artworks must be **priced \$1000 or below.**
5. A limit of **two entries per individual** applies.
6. A fee of \$15 applies for one entry or \$20 for two.
7. **Artworks must be for sale with a 25% commission.** (Please include the commission in your retail price).
8. **Works weighing over 20kgs will not be accepted** due to OHS issues.
9. **Damp work or still drying works will not be accepted.**

10. **Works on paper may be entered unframed but will be pinned or taped to the wall – it would be advisable to leave a border around your artwork to allow for this.** If the paper is delicate/fragile such as tissue or foil, it must be framed.
11. **Framed works must have D rings attached** approx 5cms down the frame on either side. If your work is a painting on canvas then D rings must be attached to the stretchers. D rings can be purchased from framers and hardware stores.



12. **This is an acquisitive award and \$2000 will be paid for the winning entry regardless of price. The work will be acquired by Tuggeranong Arts Centre on behalf of Rotary Club of Tuggeranong for the community.**
13. Tuggeranong Arts Centre staff and immediate families, board members and their immediate families are not eligible for the award.
14. Artwork will only be accepted if this **entry form accompanies the work**. All artworks must have your name and contact number on the reverse (this is additional to the entry form).
15. **Artworks must be collected between 9am – 5pm on Monday 30 June.** If your artwork has sold, you will be advised the Friday before. Uncollected works will be disposed of at the discretion of TAC due to lack of storage space.
16. All due care will be taken with artworks however **no responsibility will be accepted for any damage to artworks** whilst they are on TAC premises.
17. The artist agrees that **artworks may be reproduced for the purposes of promoting the competition and exhibition** in which case there will be no financial payment but the artist will be credited with the work.
18. **Artists are responsible for delivering and collecting their works** – TAC will not be responsible for any freight/delivery charges.
