# **PowerPoint COMPETITION** Grades 6 - 12

## **RULES, INFORMATION, & JUDGING CRITERIA**

The PowerPoint Presentation Competition promotes design creativity and allows students to incorporate what they have learned about the honored country of Canada through the overall presentation, graphic design, and written word. This competition is a wonderful tool to acquaint students with PowerPoint, an increasingly valuable program in the business world, all while exposing them to international culture. First, second, and third place winners will be chosen in each age bracket. The competition is open to 6-12 grade students attending any public, private or home school within Shelby County. Each entry must be submitted on a PC-readable CD, along with a printed version of the PowerPoint presentation and a completed PowerPoint Presentation Competition entry form. Entries must be received by Memphis in May no later than 5:00pm on Friday, March 25, 2016.

## **Judging Criteria**

**1.** The theme must focus on the culture of Canada. The PowerPoint presentation should include slides on the following: History, Geography, Language, Food, Music/Dance, and Religious Beliefs.

**2.** Along with the theme, students must create a consistent design to appear on each slide. This could be a graphic, logo, or slogan.

**3.** The PowerPoint presentation must be between 10-15 slides for high school, and between 8-10 slides for middle school.

**4.** <u>High school entries</u>: The PowerPoint presentation must be an original design of the student. Students may not use any of the templates that come with the PowerPoint software.

Middle school entries: Students may use pre-made templates.

**5.** <u>High school entries</u>: Students must include the use of additional components on their presentation, such as web links, pictures, music, games, videos, etc.

<u>Middle school entries</u>: Students must include the use of components such as pictures and web links in their presentation.

**6.** A source slide must be included on the last PowerPoint slide for the use of all those listed under number 5.

7. All entries will be judged on design, format, creative thought, accuracy of details, factual information, inclusion of required slides and information, and how well the presentation engages and informs the audience.8. Entries will also be judged on grammar and spelling.

### Senior Division: Grades 9-12

1<sup>st</sup> place winner - \$200 Cash Prize 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner - \$100 Cash Prize 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner - \$50 Cash Prize

### Junior Division: Grades 6-8

1<sup>st</sup> place winner - \$200 Cash Prize 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner - \$100 Cash Prize 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner - \$50 Cash Prize

#### ALL AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED AT A SPECIAL AWARDS RECEPTION ON APRIL 13, 2016 in the Auditorium at the Shelby County Schools, Teaching and Learning Academy.

#### It is important that all winners be present at the awards ceremony to receive their prizes.
