Results of voting. Over 1100 voters came to the polls on Tuesday and the results will have an impact on Epping schools. Voters approved a new teacher contract that will likely help keep good teachers working in Epping and attract new candidates to apply to work at our schools. The proposed budget was approved which means there should be no reduction in staff nor increase in class size. Epping Elementary School will be able to offer a computer technology class to grade 2 students for the first time and the District will be able to set aside up to \$50,000 of surplus funds to help with capital improvements. Finally, all the schools will benefit from the presence of a school resource officer whose position was also approved by voters.

Congratulations to Carrie Snyder who was elected to the School Board for the first time. Many thanks go to departing board member Greg Dodge for his six years of service on the board.

Heating Leak Forces Kindergarten Move This Week On Monday, a leak occurred in the Kindergarten wing of the building. A hot water pipe broke which spilled antifreeze in an adjacent room used for special education services. The antifreeze is water soluble, non-toxic substance used in our school's heating system to prevent frozen pipes. The condensation from the spill carried the product into the four kindergarten classrooms in the wing. Because some people may be sensitive to the odor of this non-toxic product or may complain of sore eyes, throat and nasal passages, kindergarten classes were moved temporarily to the library and computer labs.

The school has contracted with an industrial cleaning contractor to completely decontaminate the affected classrooms for the wellbeing and comfort of our children and staff. Kindergarten classes remained in the library and the labs through today. However, the cleanup should be completed by Saturday or Sunday. The cleanup involved the use of ionizers that purify the air.

Spending these days in the library and computer labs is not ideal for students. However, their teachers and paraprofessional assistants are doing an excellent job maintaining their routine and providing high-quality instruction. Students worked well in their new locations but will certainly be glad to return to their regular classrooms on Monday.
