1. Have completed at least 12 units with at least a 3.0 GPA (8 units /2.8 GPA for DSPS/employed student)
2. Be enrolled full-time for the spring 2014 term (8 units for DSPS/employed students)
3. Plan to be a continuing student for the fall 2015 term
4. Submit all application materials under the application checklist
5. Attend the CCC Scholarship Awards Ceremony on April 11, 2014 if selected as a winner
6. Write a two-page, double-spaced essay describing who or what inspires you to be diligent and how your efforts will benefit society
