CAU Member, Maurice Stephens, has truly made large efforts towards community integration, proud member of CAU.





Elizabeth, NJ - May 1, 2015 -

Maurice shared with staff he wanted to share what he has learned from the art classes he had taken in the past with CAU members, by conducting his own art classes. When he first mentioned the art group it was just an idea of talking about art or being someone's assistant in an art class. Staff followed up with the programs supervisor and an art class was scheduled for Maurice. The art classes were to take place once a month. Maurice shared with staff he was very nervous the first couple of classes, but in spite of this, Maurice felt good to be a teacher of his own class. He felt important.

When teaching the class and showing the members new drawing techniques he hopes his peers are able to go home and use the lessons learned in class for their personal art experiences. Maurice has developed from regular pencil drawing, to color pencils, markers, oil pastels and most recent to water based paint. Maurice shared him likes using the oil pastels the most. He also likes painting because you can mix and make different colors. Maurice feels a lot more confident about his abilities in teaching an art class now. His greatest accomplishment is looking back on the previous art projects and seeing the progress he has been able to come along with his peers. Maurice now has a talk show on YouTube named "Maurice and Joe Talk Show". They most recently received a new camera for filming, and will be posting new interviews very soon. Maurice is making steps to create a Facebook page for the show. At the current time he is developing a documentary on himself via audio, video, and pictures.
