Personalised Progression

The JFS Sixth Form is one of the largest and most successful in the country. Each year we have 150 applications from students wishing to transfer from other schools, mostly from the independent sector.

The reason for the high demand is simple – our 'A' Level examination results are consistently outstanding. We are one of the top performing non-selective state schools in the country year after year. With over 280 years of innovation in education and the best teaching resources and facilities available, JFS delivers proven academic achievement.

A Smooth Transition

Whether you come to us from a Jewish or non-Jewish school you will find the welcome you receive at JFS is warm and familiar. All our Sixth Form students are making a transition from Year 11 and support each other on this journey of discovery. JFS is highly sociable and an inspiring place to work and develop.

Our Sixth Form is fulfilling and stimulating for all; from positive Jewish experiences through to the enhancement provided by our comprehensive extra-curricular programme.

A Studious Environment

Students learn independently, act responsibly and demonstrate leadership, respect, care and commitment.

Sixth Form students benefit from the opportunity to lead and guide younger students, who in turn gain from this interaction. Our students are exceptional role models. They engage in charity work with Jewish and non-Jewish charities alike, locally and internationally.

The Sixth Form complex is a magnificent facility with its own dedicated Wi-Fi enabled cafeteria, study areas, photography laboratory/dark room and specialist media studio. The Sixth Form regularly hosts distinguished speakers, politicians and captains of industry who offer students inspiration and guidance for their futures.

Your Sixth Form career

Most students embark on four 'AS' Level subjects in Year 12 and will continue with three of these in Year 13, with some choosing to study four. A few students are enrolled on a three 'AS' Level programme in Year 12 whilst some may wish to take an additional 'AS' Level subject in Year 13. All 'AS' Level students will sit modular examinations at the end of Year 12.

Those studying Further Mathematics usually do this as a fifth subject in Year 12. There are GCSE re-sit courses in English and Mathematics.

A springboard for success

Our university preparation programme is nationally recognised. Our experienced staff utilise their expertise to provide individualised guidance and advice to students, helping every student to make the right choice of university and course. This is acknowledged by the Sutton Trust who rank JFS in the top five schools in the UK for successfully helping students gain entry into Russell Group universities and by the Schools Network who awarded JFS 'Leading Edge Status' as an outstanding Specialist School. We have produced a guide to Higher Education which is used extensively by other schools nationwide.

Academic progress is closely monitored by our dedicated and professional team of Tutors and pastoral Heads of Year. They are led by an inspirational Head of Sixth Form and assisted by a nationally recognised University and Careers Adviser.

The broadest curriculum, the best facilities

JFS has unparalleled facilities allowing us to specialise in the widest possible range of curriculum options.

Students flourish academically and all our staff are subject specialists. Our rigorous curriculum includes not only Art, English, French, Geography, History, Ivrit, Mathematics, Music, PE, Religious Studies, Science and Technology but extends to Computing, Dance, Economics, Psychology, Sociology, Theatre Studies and much more. We also provide a Childcare Course and a BTEC in Hospitality. We pride ourselves in offering a programme which enables every student to reach their full potential. Our dedicated pastoral team support each student and nurture their individual ability and talent.

JFS offers students diverse and life-altering experiences. We provide a rich and varied programme of educational extra-curricular activities that enhance our students' academic progress and enrich their personal development.

In the Sixth Form, our students participate in educational visits, both domestic and international. All students take part in Physical Education activities and are encouraged to engage in a multitude of extracurricular programmes. These include our debating club, the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme, Young Enterprise, the student newspaper, a diverse array of societies.

Our students are given opportunities to expand their horizons and develop their individual interests.

A Journey of Discovery

The outlook and practice of the School is Orthodox. However, our students come to us from diverse Jewish backgrounds, with varying levels of knowledge, experience and practice. This diversity is our strength, with a broad spectrum of youth developing Jewish values together.

Our formal Jewish Education programme engages students in lively debate on moral issues and dilemmas that are relevant in today's world.

We use Jewish texts as a springboard to inspire and challenge. The option of joining the Text Programme provides an opportunity for the close study of Mishnah and Gemara and associated skill development in preparation for time in Israel at a yeshiva or seminary.

We pioneered Informal Jewish Education and continue to lead the field. With innovative programmes and extensive learning opportunities, stimulating social activities are available for all. Students take part in the daily Minyan, Mishnah Shiur, 'Lunch and Learn' Programmes and individual chavrutot.

Israel at the heart of the school

As a Zionist school, every student develops a relationship with Israel.

Students engage with Israel through our active Israel Society and the celebration of all Israeli festivals. We are proud that many go on to complete a year of further study, volunteering and social action in Israel before commencing university.

Prayer

At JFS we believe spirituality must be embraced and not imposed. Services are held daily and led by our students in our beautiful, purpose-built Synagogue.

Student-led social causes

Our Sixth Form led Charity Committee successfully directs the charitable activities of the whole school. JFS is committed to raising awareness of the needs of others. Students regularly raise funds for a wide range of causes, Jewish and non-Jewish, domestic and Israel based.

Students are given an introduction to communal awareness via our volunteers fair and participate enthusiastically in social action. This is the start of our students' lives as energetic volunteers within the community and their accomplishments are impressive and varied. Jewish ethos permeates the entire fabric of the School.
