

As October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month and November is Adopt a Senior Pet Month, the Pet Pantry wanted to share the story of one brave little senior cat who fought cancer, and beat it with the help of the Pet Pantry veterinary staff and was adopted as a senior and is now in a loving home with a family who saw how special she truly was.

"Pixie" came to the Pet Pantry in December of 2014 after being abandoned by her previous owner and dropped off at another rescue. That rescue contacted us and asked if we could take her and her 14 year old brother into the Pantry. Pixie was 11 years old and obviously quite set in her ways, so it took a little bit of time for her to adjust to huge change of first being abandoned and then moved to a shelter situation. She slowly came out of her shell and was put up for adoption. Remarkably, she was adopted pretty quickly.

Unfortunately, she did not get along well with the other cat in the home, and because of some health issues with her adopter she was returned to us. It was then that we noticed a large lump beginning to form under her right arm area. Surgery was done to remove the lump and it was sent off for biopsy. The results were that she had breast cancer, but it was a low grade of tumor and it looked like we got all of it out. There was no sign of spread to other organs as well. So after recovering from surgery she was put up for adoption again.

An 11 year old cat is incredibly hard to adopt out for most rescues, and now we were faced with the task of



trying to adopt out an 11 year old cat that is a breast cancer survivor who might have her tumors return at some point. Obviously not the easiest of sells to make to people, especially during a time of year when a lot of people are looking more for kittens.

However, we were again surprised when a wonderful family stepped forward and decided to take "Pixie" home with them despite her age and medical issues.

Today "Pixie" is living out her "golden years" in the lap of luxury. She has not had any recurrence of problems related to her breast cancer and, as you can see, is quite happy with her new family.

"Pixie's" story shows how older cats can still make wonderful companions for families. So don't think that just because a cat is "old" means it will be no fun for you. "Pixie's" story also demonstrates how the Pet Pantry of Lancaster County is here for animals of all ages, and we will work just as hard to adopt out the senior citizens of the furry kind as we do with those adorable little kittens.

UPCOMING EVENTS


