For the past two years he's traveled the world as a National Motivational Speaker on topics ranging but not limited to Disability Advocacy and Overcoming Obstacles. He is the author of the book Defining Autism From The Heart: From Nonverbal to National Speaker (2013), which tells of his own personal journey.

Robert Naseef, Ph.D. has practiced for over 25 years as a psychologist. He is the father of an adult son with autism. He is a graduate of Temple University, specializing in families of children with disabilities.
