



Intervention: TCAP...

Mr. P will continue to use DEA probes that we started before spring break during class

and intervention. These strategies, along with teacher-led class activities, will re-focus students on states assessed skills where we have a class-wide need in math, literacy,

and science. Exit slips have given Mr. P direction for SS probes, which are also available on DEA. During Intervention, students with YELLOW SLIPS will go to STATION A for additional, specific probes aimed at TCAP skills where our DEA benchmark #3 data discussions have highlighted needs for improvement. GREEN SLIPS on the board will send those students to STATTION B to work on some specific advanced skills. From Mr. P...

- 1. TCAP will be April 23-26!
- 2. April 1 is our kick-off of a unit of study on weather. The culmination of this unit will be a visit to or from a local meteorologist and student produced weathercasts!



- 3. Starting April 1, students will need to put in some extra time after school in preparation for the big TCAP test that will start on April 23. Mr. P will have a tutoring schedule available at that time for those interested.
- 4. Current 6th graders will need an updated Tennessee Immunization Certificate before attending seventh grade. Proof of two additional immunizations is required by state law: Tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis booster ("Tdap"): not required if a Td booster dose given less than 5 years before 7th grade entry is recorded

on the DTaP/Td line. Verification of immunity to varicella; (2 doses or history of disease). Only proof of the two additional immunizations is required on the new immunization certificate, which will be attached to the certificate in your child's school record. Parents are encouraged to have children vaccinated this spring and provide the updated certificate to the school before students leave for summer break. Seventh grade students cannot attend school in August without an updated certificate on file at the school. Parents are encouraged to schedule a visit with the child's doctor or primary care provider for the immunizations. Immunizations may be available through the Metro Public Health Department if your child has TennCare, no insurance or insurance that does not pay for vaccines. Please provide the updated immunization certificate to the school by May 17th so your child has a smooth transition to 7th grade! For More Information, contact: MNPS Customer Service 259-INFO (4636)
